

# Impact of Cryotherapy Spray (Tru-Freeze) for the Eradication of Gastric Antral Vascular Ectasia (ICE-GAVE)

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (16)

- Diagnosis of antral-predominant GAVE: Endoscopic confirmation of gastric-antral vascular ectasia affecting the antrum, without severe portal-hypertensive gastropathy. Sub-classify as nodular or non-nodular GAVE.
- Age: ≥ 18 years at the time of consent.
- Recent transfusion-dependent anemia
- No packed-RBC transfusion for GAVE-related bleeding within the last 6 months to maintain hemoglobin (Hgb)  $\geq 8$  g/dL (or  $\geq 7$  g/dL if no coronary/vascular disease).
- Standard-of-care transfusion thresholds:

### Exclusion (16)

- Other gastrointestinal pathology
- Active peptic-ulcer disease, inflammatory bowel disease, severe portal-hypertensive gastropathy, or untreated esophageal/gastric varices.
- Coagulopathy
- Known bleeding disorder or acquired coagulopathy not attributable to GAVE.
- Severe comorbidity / high procedural risk
