Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- patients with coronary artery disease
- with moderate to severe left ventricular dysfunction (ejection fraction \leq 40%),
- scheduled for elective CABG surgery

Exclusion (11)

- associated chronic stroke, TIA , carotid occlusive disease(due to abnormal vasomotor activity), patients with known neurological impairment (cerebral infarction , dementia), significant carotid artery stenosis ,
- valvular heart disease,
- persistent arrhythmias,
- congestive cardiac failure,
- on mechanical ventilation,
