Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (5)

- Diagnosed cases of hemiplegic cerebral palsy
- Both genders are included
- The children were between 5 and 12 years old.
- Their motor function was at a level I or II based on the GMFCS,
- The degree of spasticity grade 1 to 2 based on the Modified Ashworth Scale.

Exclusion (7)

- Visual or hearing loss
- Cognitive impairment
- Seizures
- A botulinum toxin injection in the previous six months,
- Lower extremity surgery
