

# Tampa Scale for Kinesiophobia in Pelvic Pain (TSK-PP). Adaptation, Translation, and Psychometric Validation.

## Plain Language Summary

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This study is adapting and validating a questionnaire — called the Tampa Scale for Kinesiophobia for Pelvic Pain (TSK-PP) — designed to measure fear of movement in women with chronic pelvic pain. Many people with chronic pain become afraid to move because they fear it will make their pain worse, and this study aims to measure that fear more accurately in Spanish-speaking patients.

**\*\*You may be eligible if...\*\***

- You are 18 years old or older
- You have chronic pelvic pain
- You can read and understand Spanish

**\*\*You may NOT be eligible if...\*\***

- You cannot read or understand Spanish
- You are unwilling to sign an informed consent form

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (4)

- Age 18 years or older.
- Presence of chronic pelvic pain.
- Ability to read and understand Spanish.
- Signed informed consent provided prior to participation.

### Exclusion (2)

- Inability to read or understand Spanish.
- Refusal or failure to provide informed consent for participation in the study
