Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (6)

- Adult women (≥18 years old).
- Undergoing benign vaginal gynecologic surgery with indwelling catheter during surgery.
- No bladder injury during surgery.
- Ability and willingness to consent.
- No known neurological or urinary conditions affecting voiding.
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (4)

- Bladder injury during surgery.
- Neurological disease affecting bladder function.
- Active urinary tract infection.
- Inability to void either standing in shower or sitting (depending on randomization).
