Inclusion (6)

- Age from 18 to 65 years
- Self-identifies as a person who currently stutters
- Right-handed or left-handed
- Normal hearing and (corrected) vision
- Able to understand and give informed consent
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (21)

- Cardiac pacemaker or pacemaker wires; neurostimulators; implanted pumps
- Metal in the body (rods, plates, screws, shrapnel, dentures, IUD) or metallic particles in the eye
- Facial tattoos
- Not having medical insurance
- Surgical clips in the head or previous neurosurgery
