Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (21)

- Patients, aged e 1 day old, diagnosed with CBDs (e.g., hemophilia, von Willebrand disease, and other coagulation factor deficiency) who are diagnosed with dengue infection, based on WHO criteria as follow;
 - Clinical dengue infection:
 - Symptoms of high sustained fever for 3-7 days with 2 of the following: headache, retroorbital pain, myalgia, arthralgia/bone pain, hemorrhagic manifestation, positive tourniquet test, leukopenia (WBC d5000/uL)
 - Probable dengue infection:
 - Positive dengue IgM
- ... and 16 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (1)

- Patients with CBDs with dengue infection who are not willing to participate in the study
