Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Age \geq 18 years and \leq 65 years old.
- American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA) physical status II-III.
- Body mass index 18-35 kg/m².
- Patients who have a confirmed diagnosis of lung cancer and are scheduled for elective open-lung surgery.

Exclusion (8)

- Allergy to local anesthetics.
- Known psychiatric or neurologic disorders.
- Alcohol or narcotics abuse.
- Contraindications to thoracic epidural or suprascapular block, or interscalene block, e.g., coagulopathy or local infection.
- Pre-existing shoulder symptoms.
