Inclusion (4)

- Pediatric patients (<18 years)
- Diagnosis of anorectal malformation with perineal or vestibular fistula
- Surgical correction with PSARP (or variants), ASARP, or TAP
- Signed informed consent from parents/legal guardians

Exclusion (3)

- Age >18 years
- Other types of anorectal malformations
- Surgical technique other than those specified
