Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (6)

- Nulliparous pregnant women
- Age between 15 and 45 years
- Singleton pregnancy, term (37-41 weeks gestation)
- Cephalic presentation
- Active labor defined as cervical dilation e4 cm with regular contractions
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (9)

- Multiple gestation or high-risk pregnancy (preeclampsia, gestational diabetes, etc.)
- Known allergy or contraindication to tramadol or paracetamol
- Recent use (less than 6 hours) of any analgesic medication
- Previous cesarean section or other uterine surgery
- Active infection or fever at admission
- ... and 4 more (see full listing online)
