Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (17)

- ASA score less than 3, Signed informed consent, Absence of preoperative drug administration that affects patient's perception of pain, No active infection process, BMI index $>18,5 \text{ kg/m}^2$ and $< 35 \text{ kg/m}^2$, CABG, Age 18-75 years
- High severity according to ASA (class IV or higher), which is associated with a high probability of prolonged mechanical ventilation, hemodynamic instability, and inability to use drugs affecting cardiac output and/or total peripheral vascular resistance.
- Contraindications to the use of tadalafil and/or morphine in accordance with the approved Summary of Product Characteristics (hypersensitivity to tadalafil, morphine, other opioids, or any excipients).
- Pregnancy or lactation.
- Acute or prolonged chronic intoxication with drugs or substances depressing the central nervous system (alcohol, barbiturates, opioid drugs, benzodiazepines).
