Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (11)

- Male or female aged ≥ 18 years
 - Symptomatic atherosclerotic peripheral artery disease;
 - Intermittent claudication; with ankle/arm blood pressure ratio < 0.90 or artery stenosis $\geq 50\%$ in addition to at least one of the following;
 - ≥ 1 vascular bed affected by atherosclerosis
 - Diabetes
- ... and 6 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (12)

- Contraindication to colchicine or iodinated contrast
 - Long term requirement for colchicine for another clinical indication
 - Active diarrhoea
 - Recent lower limb revascularisation for symptomatic disease (< 6 weeks)
 - Renal failure (glomerular filtration rate < 30 mL/min/1.73 m²)
