---

### Inclusion (3)

- years old at the moment of recruitment and allocation.
- Minimum facility stay of 6 months since the beginning of the study.
- Documented records of recent aggressive behavior.

### Exclusion (2)

- Neurological disorder, brain injury, or psychiatric pathology that affects cognitive functions or advises against use of virtual reality.
- Not being fluent in Spanish.
